



Arts among les arbres: Friday, Nov. 13, 2009, saw the inauguration of the first annual **Arts Among Les Arbres**. The event took place at Club Roma. A group of 120 students representing the culinary, music and visual arts took part in morning and afternoon workshops, separated by a luncheon. The day's workshops offered a variety of possibilities including aboriginal art, banquet preparation & service, ceramics, choir, drumming, floral design, jazz band, jazz vocal, and piano.

Following the day's workshops, an evening art show and cabaret performance involving student and professional artists and entertainers took place.
